Through this policy we endeavour to –

- Consistently monitor our operating efficiencies to measure and reduce the number of miles travelled by our fleet through the use of telematics
- To adhere to the Waste Hierarchy with an aim of reducing the amount of waste that enters the waste stream and increase recycling and assist our customers using that experience.
- To reinforce our Zero to Landfill pledge by using alternatives to landfill wherever possible. Currently we favour the incineration of non-recyclable wastes for purposes of energy production but will always look to use emerging technologies to manage the impact of the non-recyclable waste we handle and first and foremost recycle what we can.
- Reduce the journey of the waste by sourcing waste treatment solutions close to the point of waste generation ensuring wherever possible that the waste is treated and utilised in the UK returning power and/or other such resource that arises from the waste treatment back into the local economy.
